1. GREYCELLS' PARTNERSHIP WITH THE KOFI ANNAN FOUNDATION 'S CHANGEMAKERS PROGRAMME / PARTENARIAT DE GREYCELLS AVEC LE PROGRAMME CHANGEMAKERS DE LA FONDATION KOFI ANNAN.

The Kofi Annan Foundation (KAF) Changemakers Programme started in 2021 and in 2023 an MoU was signed between the Kofi Annan Foundation and Greycells to continue their collaboration. Greycells served as mentors of the twelve Changemakers. Our member Mohan Panicker coordinated once more the mentors' group and ensured smooth and intense communications with the KAF, particularly Ms Corinne Momal-Vanian and Linda Peterhans, on the management of the mentorship.

Corinne Momal-Vanian, Executive Director of the Kofi Annan Foundation and Alejandro Bonilla García, President of Greycells; signed on 9 March 2023, an agreement to continue in 2023, the intergenerational collaboration on the prestigious KAF "Changemakers" initiative.

2. ELECTIONS IN MEXICO - KOFI ANNAN FOUNDATION

Dr. Dong, member of Greycells since 2020, former UN staff expert in electoral assistance and one of our Greytalk speakers, residing in Mexico, asked Greycells to introduce him to the Kofi Annan Foundation for their eventual intervention in Mexico to support the integrity of the



electoral process, currently undermined by proposals from the President of Mexico to reform the Constitution and the Supreme Court, proposals which are strongly opposed by civil society. Alejandro organized a discussion between Dr. Dong and Corinne Momal Vanian, Executive Director of the Foundation, to explore ways to defuse tensions and strengthen democratic institutions, including by organizing an eventual mission of Corinne to Mexico. Manuela shared the experience of the weakening of electoral integrity in Venezuela as a background to the discussion and provided information on a Venezuelan independent researcher working on this matter since 2004.

This intergenerational dialogue offered a dynamic exchange platform that highlighted the policies of the City of Geneva regarding the elderly, while juxtaposing them with the international standards and principles that have been recently discussed or adopted. As Geneva stands out for its advancement in the field, the rapidly evolving demographic reality calls for constant and forward-looking reflection. The session allowed participants to explore how Geneva compares to international initiatives, notably the project of an International Convention on the Rights of Older Persons initiated in 2013.

Within this demographic dynamic, the role of the elderly in our societies is growing in importance. They are not only valuable actors in our families, offering wisdom and experience, but also active and committed members of our communities. However, are their perspectives well understood by other generations? How do the young perceive the elderly, and how do the latter see themselves in this constantly evolving society? In this dialogue, we will seek to weave these intergenerational threads, to understand and to value the contributions and experiences of everyone. In this quest for mutual understanding, we aspire to build a society that recognizes and cherishes the richness brought by each generation.

28. THE ROLE OF INTERNATIONAL GENEVA IN THE UN 2.0



Multilateralism, and more specifically the role of the UN, is under threat. The crisis is not confined to the security and political dimensions. Far beyond the paralysis of the Security Council, it also concerns all other domains of international values, rules, goals and cooperation, from health to human rights, trade to environment, internet governance to social policies.

New York diplomacy is deeply affected and makes the headlines very often, heavily focused on the paralysis of the Security Council and the political debates at the General Assembly. The "International Geneva" is also affected but it is less visible in the news, often forgotten or underestimated. Inevitably, a process of adjustment and adaptation of multilateralism to new political, military, economic, social, and environmental forces will start – is already starting, insofar as we are already in a sort of new Cold War. The risk of resorting to improvised solutions, fragmented reactions and short-sighted decisions is high: future agreements and new mechanisms should be grounded on analysis and in-depth debates and cannot ignore the role of civil society that is paramount for legitimacy and sustainability.

The ecosystem of International Geneva: what it is and why it matters?

The agenda of multilateral issues addressed by the International Geneva is very broad, complex and essential for any « UN 2.0 » that humankind can envisage if it survives. It should not be seen as a « collateral » piece attached to the political agenda but rather as located **at the core of the multilateral system.** The ecosystem of the International Geneva encompasses 40 international organisations (including five UN specialised agencies and several UN entities), 180 Permanent Missions, 400 NGOs. Almost all the "non-military threats" and the "roots of current multifaceted crises" are addressed in Geneva. This ecosystem is highly «technical», complicated and diverse, covering more than the 17 SDGs. It matters, in particular, because of three main features: (i) its **normative and regulatory work** in many economic, social, environmental and human rights areas; (ii) its **impact at the country level** by transforming the research and rules into concrete world-wide technical assistance; (iii) it is **a puzzle**: it is the main multilateral crossroads of intersectoral, multidisciplinary issues characterising today's increasingly complex globalisation and crises. (Please refer to the **Reference Note on the role of International Geneva**, that sets the background of this Dialogue).

Main features of this Intergenerational Dialogue:

The overarching goal is to highlight **the specificities of the multilateral work done by the International Geneva** in the context of the preparations of the UN Summit of the Future and beyond. This Dialogue is genuinely **intergenerational**, involving young and less young experts and non-experts in multilateral affairs, and it provides a **civil society perspective** through nongovernmental entities based in Geneva, New York and other capitals around the world.

The **main target audiences** are diplomats, decision-makers, academics, journalists, students, civil society and the general public, particularly in New York and in Geneva. The Dialogue is not an academic exercise: it is meant to complement rather than competing with other initiatives related to the Summit.


